

They feel inadequate to live out their faith, much less share their faith with someone else. Making disciples, maturing followers of Jesus, takes more time and effort at the beginning, but pays off in the long run because a mature follower of Christ will share his faith with others—winning others to faith in Jesus.


### **FUN WITH A SPREADSHEET**

# **ROCK Groups**







## **BIBLE STUDY CURRICULUM**
















## **STARTING YOUR GROUP**
